Challenging and fun projects encourage collaboration, decision making, and innovation. Students work together to solve problems, while developing a love of math and science.



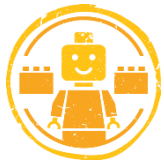
## Mission Possible

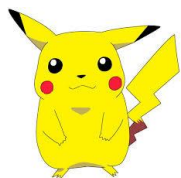

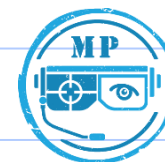

\*A registration fee of \$25 (non-refundable) is required to enroll for summer camp. A deposit of \$230.00, which will pay for your final week of camp, must be paid at the time of registration (non-refundable).

\*Weekly payments are due on the first day of the week by 9:00am. A \$25 per day late payment fee will be assessed beginning the second day at 12:00pm.

\*Since all camp programs are prescheduled, any changes (additions/deletions) to originally selected programs must be made **in writing** at least TWO FULL WEEKS IN ADVANCE of requested change. All requests for cancellations made after this deadline will not be accommodated and payment will be required.
