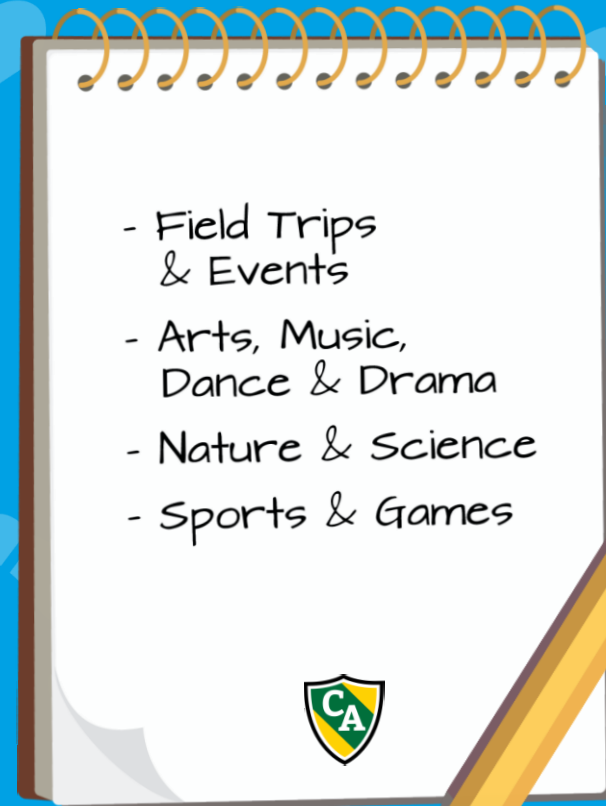

July 24th-28th

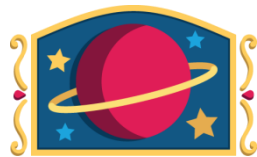
