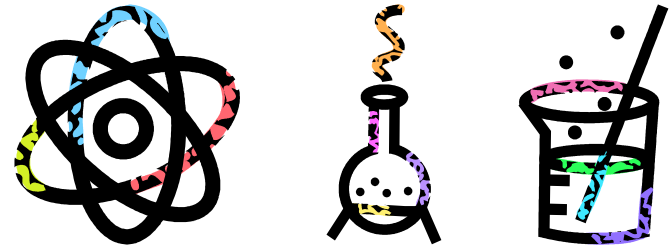

Each week, campers head to the swimming pool at Marsh Creek State Park. Campers enjoy a relaxing swim in the near half acre size pool. Our junior campers remain in the shallow end while our senior campers can take a swim test to swim in the deep end. Campers will participate in a customized 4 day experience at Sunset Valley which will include lessons on how to care for horses, riding lessons and a craft.
