Monday you will receive a re-enrollment sheet that will give you details about the re-enrollment process. You will have from December 8th until January 30th to submit your information and hold your child's spot for the upcoming school year. An incentive will be offered to students.

In elementary we are looking to fill classrooms with a max of 15 students this year. Our preschool classroom and intermediate classrooms will fill to 18. Our enrollment process will be first come first serve!
