

Recipe of the Month

Gingerbread Waffles w/ Hot Chocolate Sauce

Courtesy of allrecipes.com Ingredients 1 cup light molasses 1/2 cup butter 1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda ¹/₂ cup of milk 1 eqq 2 cups all-purpose flour 1 1/2 teaspoons ground ginger 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon



stir until smooth.

1. In a small saucepan, heat molasses and 1/2 cup butter until almost boiling. Remove from heat and let cool slightly. Stir in baking soda, milk and egg. 2. In a large bowl, sift together flour, ginger, cinnamon and salt. Make a well in the center and pour in the molasses mixture. Mix until smooth. 3. Spray preheated waffle iron with non-stick cooking spray. Pour mix onto hot waffle iron. Cook until golden brown. Serve hot with chocolate sauce. 4. To make chocolate sauce: In a saucepan, combine water, 1 cup sugar, cornstarch, cocoa powder and 1 teaspoon salt. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until mixture comes to a boil. Remove from heat and add vanilla and 2 tablespoons butter; Winter Break
