Strawberry Santa Hats

Ingredients:

Strawberries with the bottoms cut off

1 bag of Wilton white chocolate disks

Frosting (can of frosting from the grocery store works fine)

Jar of sugar crystals for dipping and "snow"

"Sixlets" from Party City

Directions:

Make sure your strawberries are thoroughly dry otherwise the chocolate will not properly adhere to the berry. Use a bag of Wilton white chocolate disks in a double boiler. Once your chocolate has melted (you can use a bit of shortening to make it smooth) dip the bottom of the strawberries in the chocolate then roll in sugar crystals. Set on a cookie sheet lined with wax paper. Once the chocolate has set, remove the strawberries from the cookie sheet and placed them on a pretty tray. Put frosting in a ziploc bag and cut the corner a little and pipe frosting on the tip of the strawberry and lightly push the Sixlet into the frosting.
