Like so many traditions and celebrations impacted by the pandemic, we all know Thanksgiving may need to be approached a little differently this year. In particular, the CDC has published Thanksgiving/Holiday-specific COVID-19 guidance cautioning against "higher-risk" activities, which include the following:

- Attending large indoor gatherings with people from outside of your household
