Payment Policy: One week's tuition is due at time of enrollment. The deposit is applied to the final week of camp. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday. A \$25 late fee is charged if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday.

Cancellation Policy: If you enroll in camp and your plans change, or you have concerns about your child attending camp this summer, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. Program change request must be received 2 weeks prior to enrolled camp week start date. Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not contact us to cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.
