

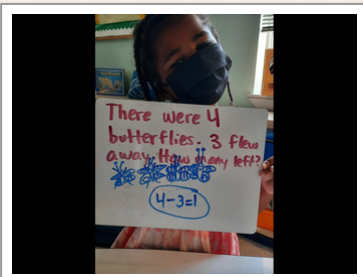
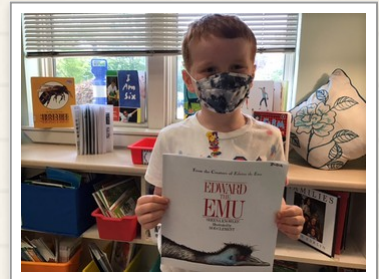
First Grade News

WEEK IN REVIEW

READING

This week in Reading we read "First Day Jitters". We wrote about our first day of first grade and our "Jittery Feelings". We also explored characters, setting, and plot in the story. We also read "Edward the Emu". We worked on making predictions, character details, and comprehension. We explored vocabulary in the story such as *bask*, *detest*, *clamber*, *amusing*, *snarl*, and *gumption*. We also practiced reading and comprehending fiction and non-fiction passages.



MATH

This week in Math we practiced skip-counting by 2's, 5's, and 10's to 100. We worked on addition and subtraction within 20. We also practiced with word problems and strategies to help break down word problems.
