## DEAR FAMILIES,

Welcome to the month of November. November is that transitional month that comes between Fall and Winter. The leaves are falling from the trees, the days are shorter, and there's a real chill in the air. It's Fall Harvest Time!

This week was a great week as we continued exploring skills in our Links To Learning Curriculum. We engaged in activities relating to the letter of the week "li". We identified the letter li as a vowel which makes a short and long vowel sound. We named words beginning with li sound and words with the /i/ sound in the middle of the word.

We identified ways to represent a number. Our number of the week was 14. We matched objects to numbers, identified the number that comes before and after a number and we counted by 1's, 5's and 10's to 100.

During this month, the students will explore the concept of living vs. non-living things; identify the five senses and the corresponding body part; recognize numbers 11-40 and create original patterns.

Our Links to Learning curriculum skills focus for the month will be:

\*Language /literacy:

-Responds to "why" and "how" questions.

\*Mathematics:

- Counts objects in two groups to determine which group has more.

\*Science and Social Studies :

-Identify the five senses and the corresponding body parts.

\*Citizens of the World:

-Review previously Spanish vocabulary.

\*Wellness:

-imitates complex body movements.

Creative Expression:

-identify simple musical instruments by sound.

\*Social-Emotional:

- Uses basic table manners.

\*Digital Interactions:

-Identify some forms of technology that assist with the five senses (glasses, hearing aids).
