## Dear Chesterbrook Parents,

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year! The school year officially starts on Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>. We are very excited to not only welcome back many of our returning families, but we also have many new additions starting school for the first time! Each year our family grows, and we couldn't be more excited!

#### Here are just a few friendly reminders...

- ullet Tuition is due every Monday by noon to avoid a \$25 late fee.
- •We have an ACH program that allows us to automatically withdrawal the tuition from your account each week. You may also pay by credit or debit card; please be advised there is a 2% process fee to run your card. If you would like to take advantage of either one of these options, please inform us in the office.
- Please remember to check your child in and out for every drop-off and pick-up. The IPAD is conveniently located on the front desk. Simply punch in your 4 digit number and tap your child's face once it comes up to ensure they are properly checked in or out. If you do not have your 4 digit number, please see the front desk and we will create your number for you.
- Please provide a copy of your child's immunization records along with the completed Universal Child Health Form that your pediatrician can fill out for you.
- Please see the flyer we will be sending home with our new door code on it. For security purposes, please do not share the front door code with anyone. If someone on your authorized list is picking up, we will kindly buzz them into the school.
- If you are interested in signing your child up for any of our extracurricular activities, the sign-up sheets are located on the front desk. Each activity is \$14 per week per class. Each signup sheet lists the day and time for the activity so you can plan accordingly and arrive on time for each activity.
