Can you believe it's only two and a half months away from graduation?! While March was an exciting month, April has even more exciting events coming up. We will be learning all about the weather and clouds. We will also be exploring our solar system. To celebrate Earth Day, we will be releasing lady bugs and learning all about the three R's. Some of our Links to Learning skills this month we'll be mastering are: matching pennies, nickels and dimes to their associated values, read and recognize more sight words, and use adjectives to describe an object. The memories this year have been the best and we are so excited to continue making memories that will last a life time!

<u>Kindergarten</u>

This month we are focusing on initial medial and final Ee, Jj, Ww, Ks, and Uu, mastering the sight words from, go, here, blue, green, yellow, reading text based comprehension such as cause and effect, realism and fantasy, classify and categorize, and setting in Language Arts, mastering measurement, classifying objects, reviewing time and money in Mathematics, finishing our Habitats unit in Science, learning national symbols and first Americans in Social Studies.
