## Parent Reminders

- Tuition rates increased this week.
- Tuition is due every Friday for the upcoming week. Your account will be charged a late fee of \$25 if it has not been paid by Tuesday morning.
- Please keep in mind that we have children with very severe allergies. Therefore, we cannot allow any nut products to be brought into our school. If you choose to send your child in with sun butter, please label it as such.
- Check with your child's teacher often to see if your child is missing any items such as extra clothes, sun screen, etc.
- Please label your child's belongings with their initials. Anything that is consumed must have their first and last name and date on it.
- Vacation requests need to be given at least 2 weeks in advance. You are permitted one free week of vacation time per year once your child has been here for a consecutive 6 months.
- If you are withdrawing your child, please keep in mind that a 4 week written notice must be given.
- We are required to take the children outside everyday, however, their safety is always our first concern. We may have to limit their time outside or possibly not go out at all. If it is code red, they are not outside at all. We are constantly hydrating the children throughout the day. They have access to water at all times, even on the playground and field trips.

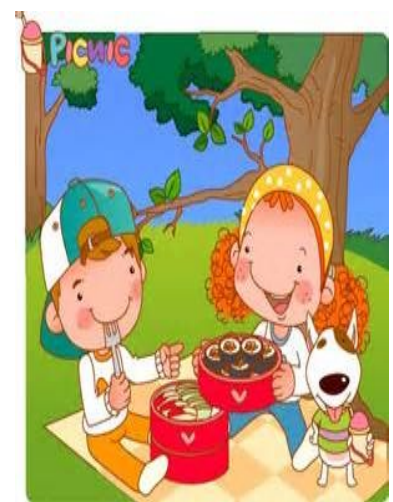

## Patriotic Parfaits
