# Medicine/Illness

It is that time of year where there are lots of things going around. We are doing our best to disinfect and clean everything. Please help us to prevent the spread of illness by keeping sick children home. If your child does get sent home, they are required to be out of school the next day. They may return, after the missed day, provided that they have been symptom free for the prior 24 hours. Medication is given midday, typically between 12:30 and 1:00. Nebulizers and Inhalers will be given any time as needed. Please be sure that all medicine is in its original container, has the prescription label on it and that a medicine form is filled out. All medicine is kept at the front desk. Please do not leave medication in bags or cubbies, and be sure to pick it up at the end of the day. Over the counter meds must have the proper dosage for your child's age on the label.

## **Drop Off**

We have been noticing that some off the drop off/pick up procedure are not being followed. As a reminder:

\*Children must be signed in upon entering the building using the iPad on the front desk. This iPad is for ADULT use only. Please do not have your children sign themselves in.

\*Children must be taken to their classrooms by the adult dropping off. Children may never be left unattended at any time regardless of their age.

\* Take your child to their designated area.Be sure that the teacher in the room has seen you and your child when you drop off. We need to be sure that everyone gets signed into the classroom for safety reasons.

\* Be sure that when you pick up the teacher has seen you and knows that you are taking your child.

\* Sign out as you are leaving the building.
