

CBA Reopen - Reunite Frequently Asked Questions

Q. WILL PRE-K BE RETURNING TO SCHOOL IN PERSON, WITH K-5TH GRADE?

A. Yes. All of our reopening plans include our entire student body, Pre-K-5th grade. Our communication was explaining that we will be offering an online option for Pre-K, which would be a separate program from our K-5th online option. This option would be for students who wish to learn online while students are learning on campus each day.

Q. DO THE REOPENING PLANS INCLUDE BEFORE AND AFTER CARE?

A. No. Our before and after plan will be separate from our school plan at the moment. Although all of our health and safety guidelines will be the same, our ability to manage the program and the plan for student experience will be different. Our plan is to offer these programs if we are able to meet the guidance and set forth by local authorities. As of today, there is still a fair amount of uncertainty around these guidelines.

Q. COULD YOU PLEASE SHARE MORE INFORMATION ABOUT THE ONLINE ACADEMY?

A. Yes. We are putting together more information for this program. The biggest hurdle is understanding the interest from our families, which is why we have asked for your interest by July 17th. After we have an idea of how many students might be attending our OA, we will be better suited to give you some specific answers. One question that we can answer is around the option to transfer in and out of OA. This is yes, and no. The option to transfer in and out will be restricted by academic quarters. For example, once you have enrolled, you will have to remain in the OA for the current quarter. This will allow for a more natural transition back to the brick and mortar, should you desire.

Q. WILL YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES CHANGE?

A. Yes. We will adjust these guidelines as they are adjusted locally. We factor in a number of resources when developing our health and safety plan and it is a working document that we will change as needed to ensure adherence and the utmost safety for our community.

Q. WHEN WILL YOU MAKE YOUR FINAL DECISION ON YOUR REOPENING PLAN?

A. Like most schools at the moment, we are in a "wait and see" and "plan for every scenario". As frustrating as this is, the fluidity of the Covid situation just does not allow for a decision to be made right now. We, too, would love to be able to plan for one scenario but it is not something that we can do. You can trust that we will communicate regularly any updates and when we know, you will know.
