

<ul> <li>Completes 10- to 20-piece puzzles</li> <li>Repeats a pattern using up to three objects</li> <li>Begins to interpret data presented in bar graphs</li> <li>Explains common occurrences using simple reasoning</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Engages in pretend play connected to the weekly story</li> <li>Engages in pretend play roleplaying winter weather experiences (snow, winter clothing)</li> <li>Digital Interactions</li> </ul>
