

	Identifies age     Identifies characteristics of self (hair color, gender, eye color)

<ul> <li>Identifies the beginning of a story</li> </ul>	MUSIC AND MUSICIANS	
WRITING <ul> <li>Holds a crayon or other writing utensil correctly</li> <li>Draws an arc on paper</li> <li>Makes scribble marks that resemble some letter forms on paper</li> <li>"Reads" own writing aloud</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Claps an ABAB rhythmic pattern with music (hand-knees-hand-knees)</li> <li>Sings familiar songs</li> <li>Moves body expressively with music</li> <li>Identifies music as fast or slow</li> </ul>

2) Mathematics	<ul> <li>Creates 3D art using various materials</li> <li>Paints on a vertical surface (fence, classroom wall, easel)</li> </ul>	
NUMBERS AND NUMBER SENSE	Creates art using basic shapes	
• Counts from 1–20	DRAMATIC PLAY	
<ul> <li>Understands the number concepts of one to five</li> <li>Counts items in groups of 1–5</li> <li>Uses fingers to represent numbers 1–5</li> <li>Tells which is one and which is many</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Engages in pretend play connected to the weekly story</li> <li>Dramatizes movements of different animals</li> </ul>	
GEOMETRY AND RELATIONSHIPS		
<ul> <li>Names shapes and colors (primary and most secondary)</li> <li>Does simple matching of color, shapes, and objects</li> <li>Matches shapes regardless of orientation (e.g. triangle and upside-down triangle)</li> <li>Matches simple 3D shapes to simple 2D shapes</li> </ul>		
PROBLEM SOLVING AND REASONING		
<ul> <li>Completes 3- to 10-piece puzzles</li> <li>Repeats simple ABAB patterns</li> <li>Explains everyday occurrences using simple reasoning</li> <li>Uses picture references and deductive reasoning to determine who is and is not present at school</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Strings large beads</li> <li>Puts small objects in openings with increasing control</li> <li>Squeezes and manipulates Play-Doh</li> <li>Uses safety scissors</li> <li>Removes and adheres stickers to paper</li> <li>Laces lacing cards with support</li> </ul>	Removes shoes     Attempts to put shoes back on     Uses an open cup with control     Begins to follow bathrooming procedures     Expresses needs and wants

HEALTH, SAFETY, AND NUTRITION	<ul> <li>Introduced to new Spanish vocabulary</li> <li>Reviews previously acquired Spanish vocabulary</li> <li>Explores animals from around the world</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Identifies a variety of foods</li> <li>Talks about the importance of exercise</li> <li>Accepts water as a drink option</li> <li>Follows some playground safety rules</li> </ul>
