- Please remain 6 feet away from other families.
- Masks are required for 2 years old and up.

Our building opens at 7:00 am and closes at 6:00 pm. We are providing an AM snack, PM snack, and lunch. If you decide to pack extra snacks or a home lunch, it must be peanut-free and in a disposable bag. We are supplying sippy cups for Toddlers and Beginners and disposable cups for everyone else. Your child's bedding will go home daily to be cleaned. Please provide weather appropriate extra clothes that can stay here at school.

Please Remember...

- CBA is a peanut free school. We have several students with severe allergies to peanuts and tree nuts. Please refrain from sending any nut products in with your child(ren).
- Sick policy: If your child gets sent home with a fever, or due to vomiting or diarrhea they must be 72 hours symptom and medication free before returning to school.
- All paperwork must be refilled out every 6 months (physicals are needed every year).
- Tuition payments are weekly. Tuition payments are due for the following week of school. Please note a \$25 late fee is applied at 12:00 on Wednesdays for late tuition. (Sign up for ACH through ALMA to avoid late payments).
