

^{*}Payment Policy: One week's tuition is due at time of enrollment unless a deposit is already on file. We will apply the deposit to the final week of your child's enrollment with proper 4 week written notice. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday morning. We will charge a \$25 late fee if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday. Families are responsible for tuition every week unless they are eligible to use their one week of vacation. A vacation request must be submitted 2 weeks in advance. Accounts must be current to utilize this benefit and children may not attend during their free week.
