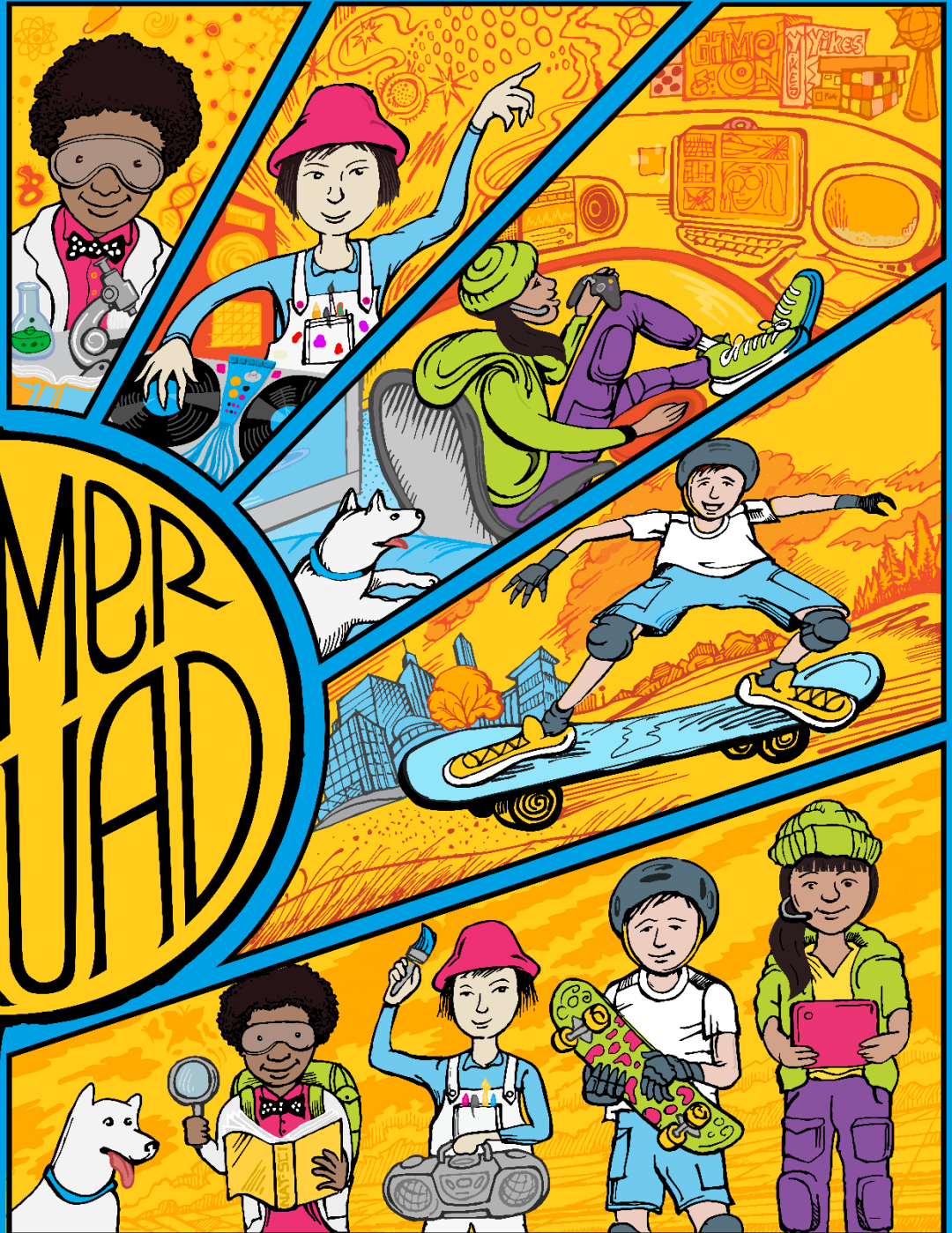

Artist Studio

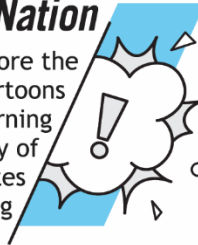
Art is more than just painting and drawings.

Our daily pep rally is a time for campers to gather for songs, chants and challenges that promote collaboration.



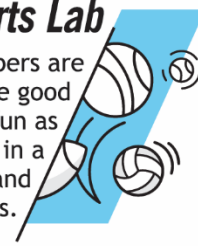
Minute to Win It

Children are immersed into the world of magic and mystery. They learn about famous magicians and the secrets behind the magic, and even perform in their own magic show.



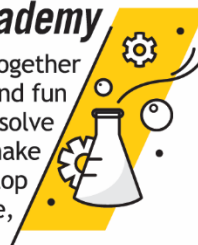
Campers Got Talent

We will apply the deposit to the final week of your child's enrollment with proper 4 week written notice. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday morning. We will charge a \$25 late fee if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday. Families are responsible for tuition every week unless they are eligible to use their one week of vacation. A vacation request must be submitted 2 weeks in advance. Accounts must be current to utilize this benefit and children may not attend during their free week.*
