Bug Spray & Sunscreen



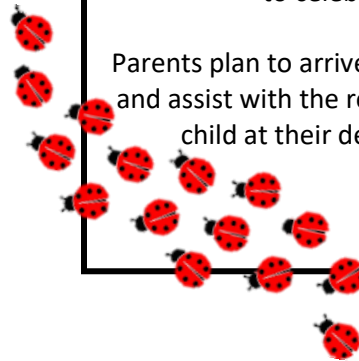
