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### Tods:

- Welcome to another month in Toddlers! In the first week of our new month, we will be talking about ice cream and celebrating Alfred L. Cralle, inventor of the ice cream scoop! This week we will be making our own ice cream and exploring related sensory elements. This will include the ice cream's cold temperature, its creamy texture, and of course the yummy taste!
- The week of the 13th we will be celebrating Valentine's Day! This week our topics will be
  hearts and love. We will be sorting hearts by size, creating a person out of paper hearts,
  and decorating cards to give to our friends! Our story this week will be "Happy Valentine's
  Day Mouse" by Laura Numeroff and Felicia Bond.
- In the 3rd week, we will be celebrating Presidents Day! We will be talking about
  Washington and Lincoln. Students will make Washington's hat out of shapes and listen to
  the story "Presidents Day" by Anne Rockwell.
- For the final week of the month, our topic will be penguins! We will be creating these cute arctic animals out of different shapes and listening to the story, "Five Little Penguins Slipping on the Ice" by Steve Metzger.

## B1:

- Happy February !!! We have an exciting month ahead of us filled with lots of fun activities, learning experiences and celebrations here at Beginner 1.
- Week 1 Its Groundhog Day on February 2nd Happy Groundhog Day friends!!! We will learn all about the famous Pennsylvania Dutch tradition "The Groundhog Day", the weather,

- shadows and read the book "Grumpy Groundhog" by Maureen Wright.
- Week 2- We will continue to explore the wonderful world of Arctic animals. This week we learn about Polar Bears and their habitat. We will read the book "If I Knew A Polar Bear" by Karen Sutula. It's fun book about a polar bear and his quirky friends.
- Week 3 It's "Valentine's Week "
   We look forward to celebrating Valentine's Day, the sweetest holiday of the year with our families, teachers and each other.
  - We are excited host a Valentine's Day party so please look out for a sign up sheet in the classroom. There will be plenty of tasty treats, crafts and games. We will read the book Clifford the Big Red Dog Valentine Surprise", a heartwarming story of how friendship is an important part of love.
- Week 4 This week we will learn a little about US history and "President's Day.
   A holiday that celebrates the birthdays of George Washington and Abraham Lincoln who were Presidents of this great nation. We will read the book "Celebrating President's Day "by Kimberly Jordano. We will make paper hats and set up a cool photo booth.

#### **B2**:

- This month we will be learning a TON of new things!
- An on going theme this month will be Black History. February is Black History Month and each week we will cover a famous black individual who helped change our world!
- Throughout the month, we also will be covering more Spanish vocabulary! So far we have learned 1-20, Hello, Goodbye, Thank you, and You're Welcome in Spanish.
- Feb 1st Week- Groundhog Day! Groundhog Day takes place in PA. Students will learn about our good ole pal Punxsutawney Phil. We will also be completing a groundhog day craft
- Feb 5th Week- Cars! Students will read books on cars, as well as complete activities involving cars. We also are going to have a race!
- Feb 12th Week- Healthy Foods. Students will learn about the different food groups and what foods we should be putting into our bodies! Good food = Fuel for our body!
- Feb 19th Week- Presidents. We will be learning about important presidents throughout our history. We will also be voting within class!
- Feb 26th Week- Women's History! This is the last week of February, going into March which is Women's History. We will be talking about important women within our history such as astronauts, activists, artists, and more!

#### Intermediates:

- Happy February!
- This month we will be spending time talking about Valentine's Day. We will talk about how
  to love ourselves and our friends by being kind. We will make a Valentine friend. Then
  there will be a small party for Valentine's Day.
- We will continue our animal unit as we visit the fam and different habitats animals live in. Some animals we will create are penguins and tigers.
- As always, please update your child's cubby with weather appropriate clothing!

### Pre-K:

 This month we will be focusing on a variety of different topics! First, we will be finishing our personal interview week! Students will name their immediate family members as well

- as the town that they live in. Then we will talk about our favorite song and game and dance the day away to our favorite music! Lastly, students will describe what they want to be when they grow up and act it out.
- Next, we focused in on our feelings and emotions! We will go a little more in-depth with feelings like excitement, nervousness, gratitude, shyness, and love! This led us into "love is in the air!" The week of Valentines day we will make valentines day crafts, write love letters to our families, do some simple math with paper hearts, and even decorate heart shaped cookies!
- Next, we are going out of this world into space! Students will learn about all of the planets in our solar system, as well as creating them! We will compare sizes, colors and the temperatures of our planets. We also examined the sun, stars, and Milkyway in general!
- The month will conclude by focusing on inventors throughout time! We will talk about who and when things we still use today were thought of and created! Woohoo for February!

### Pre-K 2:

• In February we will be learning about all different kinds of topics. We will talk about how this month is black history month and learn all about the important black people that helped the country and the world change for the better. We will then talk about one of our holidays this month, Valentine's Day! We will be writing valentines to the people we love, do some math matching games with paper hearts, and make valentines crafts for our families. To branch off from Valentine's day and the feeling of love, we will learn about some new feelings! Like love, excitement, nervousness, gratitude, and shyness. Then we'll talk about another holiday we have this month: Presidents day! We will learn about how presidents get elected, who our president is now, and even do voting activities! Then to end the month off we will talk about some community helpers! Like nurses and doctors, mail workers, teachers and more. It's gonna be a great month!

- The "Real Feel" or temperature/wind chill are above 25 degrees Fahrenheit or less than 90 degrees Fahrenheit
- There is no active precipitation
- There is no current air quality alert

This means that if the weather is okay, we will be outside to play! Please be prepared for the occasional muddied shoes or pants at pick-up - it just means we've been having FUN!

# K & S Knits: A Small Business in our Community!


