## Oral Health Presentation

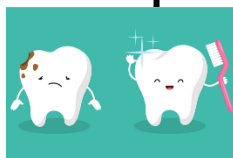
Lets Smile Pediatric Dentist will be visiting each classroom on February 7<sup>th</sup> to talk about the importance of oral health care with fun and interactive activities.
