## Full-Time Only, Starting June 2024

Hello Chesterbrook families,

This letter is to notify all of our currently enrolled families that we will no longer be offering part-time care starting in June 2024. All families who are currently on a 2 or 3 day schedule will be required to shift their schedule to 5 days, with the option of participating in either half days or full days at this time.

Please be on the lookout for more information regarding this transition in the coming months.

## Yacation Credit, Hiatus, & Withdraw Reminders

If you are traveling this summer, let us know if you are planning on using your **vacation credit**. Please remember:

- Vacation credits require two weeks' written notice in order to be utilized
- Credits reset on July 1st.
- Credits can only be utilized for a Monday-Friday absence. If a child is present for any portion of the week, regular tuition will apply.

If you are taking a **hiatus** for the summer, please note:

- We require a 30-day (4 week) written notice for a hiatus date
- We will require a specified return date before we can place your child on hiatus in order to maintain their spot on our roster.

If you are planning to withdraw your child from our program:

• Withdraws require a **30-day (4 week) written notice** in order for your enrollment deposit to be credited towards your final week's tuition.

Week 1:Hurray!!! It's Back to School week and we are excited for a fresh start to the school year. We will have an introduction week in our classroom where we talk about class routines and get to know some fun facts about our friends. Based on our theme we will read the book "Curious George First Day of School" by Margaret and H.A. Rey and create back to school artwork.

Week 2: September marks the official kickoff of the FootBall Season and we can't keep calm!!! We will be cheering for our favorite team and show our support by wearing our team jerseys. We will read the book "Football With Dad" by Frank J. Berrios.

We'll explore Fall's seasonal changes, talk about our community helpers, and create expressive "Back to School" artwork as well!

#### Pre-K:

Welcome to the school year! We can't wait for another school year in Pre-K! This month will be all about getting acclimated to the school year, the Pre-K classroom, ourselves, our peers, and our learning! We will be focusing on:

- •Getting to Know, You & Me! We will review our class rules and routines, while getting to know each other better! We will use a get to know me jar, line up for yes or no, copy cat, and make a family tree! •
- •Moods & Manners! We will look at 5 steps to managing big emotions, emotion charades, become manner detectives & more! •
- •Joys of the World! We will look at things that give us a joy. First, we will look at the sunset, learn why it happens and discuss the emotions we feel! We will relax at the beach by practicing mindful breathing to the sound of waves! September 21st is the last day of summer,

and International Peace Day! We will talk about what it means to be peaceful & why it's important. Then it will be all about love, how it makes us feel & what we love in life! ♥ •ABC, Talkin bout you & me! This week is all about gathering our general knowledge within language and literacy. We will review the letters of the alphabet, practice spelling & writing our names, as well as starting to look at simple sight words. We will learn about uppercase versus 

#### Pre-K 2:
