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Teacher Highlights

Toddlers

Ms. Laurel: Students are exploring the wonders of winter by learning how animals hibernate and adapt to colder weather, while discussing the changes we see as seasons shift.

Beginners

Ms. Faith: This month, children are discovering the concept of hibernation and how animals prepare for winter, along with learning about seasonal changes through stories, crafts, and hands-on activities.

Intermediates

Ms. Erin: In class, we're learning about winter weather, how animals stay warm through hibernation, and what changes happen as we move from fall into winter—all through fun, interactive lessons.

Pre K2

Ms. Bridget: Students are practicing early science skills as they observe season changes and learn how animals survive winter through hibernation, using books, art projects, and group discussions to bring these concepts to life.
