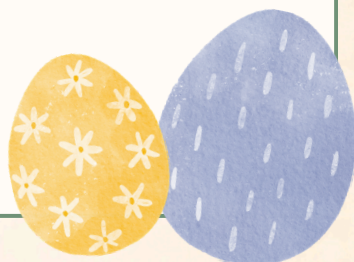

Teacher's Corner


