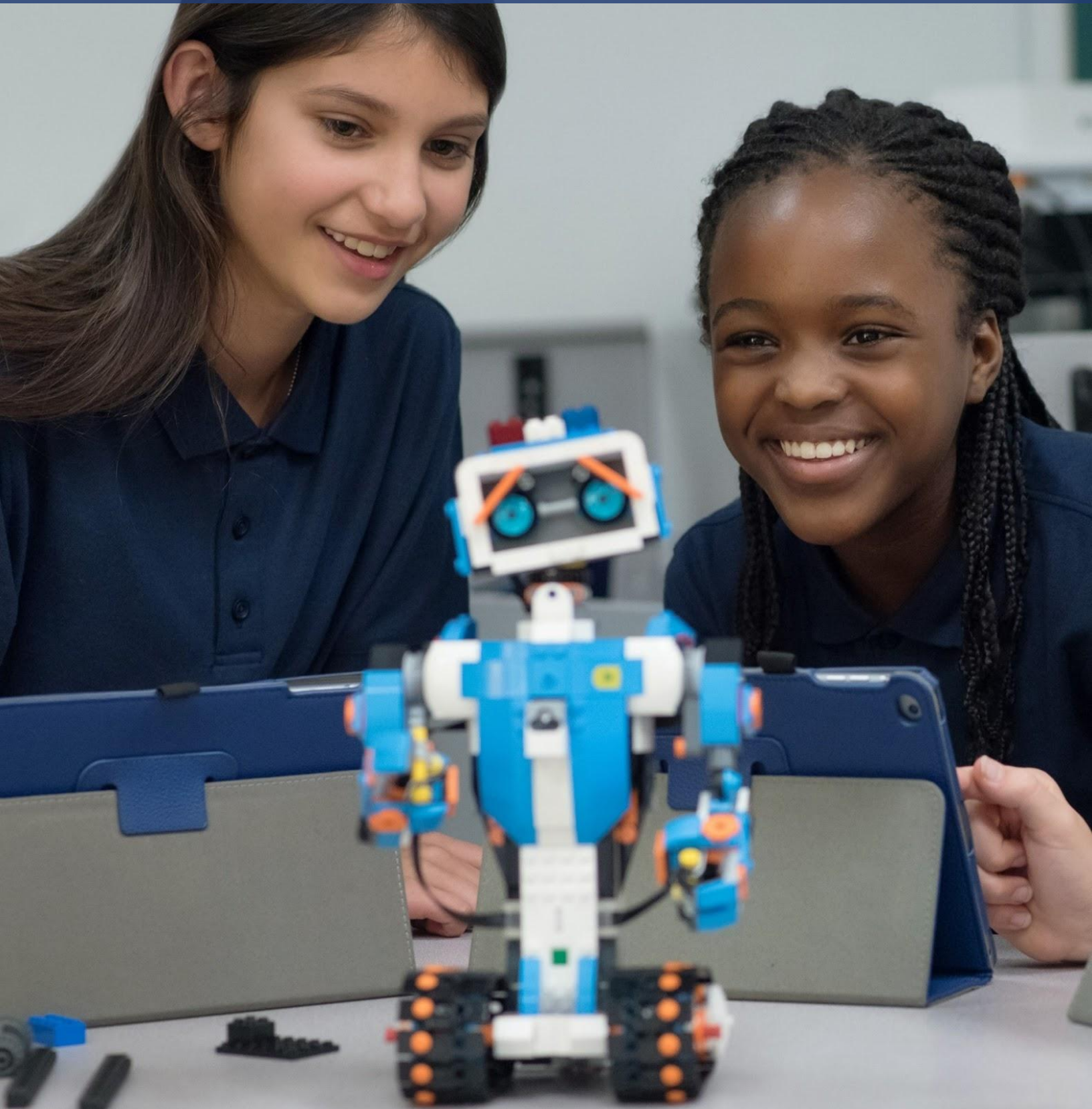

Extended Day

Our program is organized into five subject areas that are designed to provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day.



Students explore the exciting world of science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) through building projects, experiments, and design challenges. Sharing ideas, asking questions, and making predictions are encouraged!



Robust outdoor free play and structured games help students learn sportsmanship and develop their physical strength and endurance. Students learn critical thinking and problem solving by participating in board games and team challenges with their peers.



Students express themselves by participating in hands-on visual arts, including photography, videography, drawing, and painting. Students develop planning skills by working on long-term projects with their peers and can participate in group performances or discussions.



Social and emotional growth is nurtured through student and teacher led activities that promote a feeling of community and belonging. Students learn through open-ended activities that give them a chance to apply problem-solving skills and collaborate with friends.



Some students appreciate the chance for independent activities or study after a long day at school. We provide a quiet place to work on homework, read, journal, or seek academic support from peers and teachers. Students can also work on various projects in this small group setting.

General Information

Chesterbrook Academy is proud to offer **Before & After School Extended Day** and a variety of **Enrichment Programs** designed to provide students with engaging, educational, and fun experiences beyond the school day.

Our Extended Day Program offers a safe, nurturing environment where students can participate in homework time, creative activities, outdoor play, and social interaction. Our Enrichment Programs provide exciting opportunities for students to discover new interests, develop skills, and explore their passions through a wide variety of classes and activities.

Registration & Enrollment

To participate in Extended Day or Enrichment classes, all students must have:

- A completed registration form on file.

Enrollment for enrichment classes is **first come, first served**, and space is limited. We encourage families to register early to secure their preferred classes.

Payment Information

All program payments are processed through **ACH (Automatic Bank Draft)**. Please log in to your **Alma** account to verify or update your banking information before registering.

Important Policies

- Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement may be canceled. Families will be notified as soon as possible if this occurs.
- Enrichment program fees are **not prorated** for late registration.
- **All program fees are non-refundable.**
- Enrichment classes do **not** meet on school holidays, school closure days, teacher workdays, or scheduled half-days unless otherwise noted.
- Make-up classes are **not** provided for student absences or school closures due to inclement weather, emergencies, or other unforeseen circumstances.

Club & Enrichment Program

Policies

Registration & Payment

- Registration for clubs and enrichment programs is completed online during the designated enrollment period.
- Payment is due at the close of the registration period and is required to secure your child's enrollment.
- Accepted forms of payment include:
 - ACH (automatic bank withdrawal)
 - Credit Card (*2.75% processing fee applies*)
 - Check made payable to **Chesterbrook Academy**
- Families paying by ACH or credit card will be billed through their **Alma Parent Portal** after the registration period closes. Charges may not appear in your Alma account until enrollment has officially closed and registrations have been processed.

Refund Policy

- Once a club or enrichment session has begun, registrations cannot be changed or canceled.
- All club and enrichment fees are non-refundable and non-transferable once the program has started.
- Each club has a maximum enrollment based on class size, staffing, and available materials. If a program reaches capacity, students will be placed on a waitlist. Families will be notified if a space becomes available, and no payment will be processed while a student is waitlisted.
- Clubs require a minimum number of participants to operate. If minimum enrollment is not met, the club may be canceled. Families will be notified promptly, and any payments already processed will be fully refunded.
- Refunds will not be issued for student withdrawals, absences, vacations, illness, scheduling conflicts, or dismissal from a club due to behavioral concerns.

Late Pick-Up Policy

- Students not enrolled in the **R.O.A.R. Before & After School Program** must be picked up immediately following the dismissal of their scheduled club or enrichment activity.
- Students enrolled in the **R.O.A.R. After School Program** will return to the after-school program following the conclusion of their club.
- Parents arriving after their child's scheduled dismissal time will be charged a **late fee of \$5.00 per minute**.
- If a parent or authorized pick-up person has not arrived, the student will remain supervised in the school office while attempts are made to contact the parent or an individual listed on the student's emergency contact form.
- Repeated late pick-ups may result in additional administrative action or the loss of club participation privileges.

Club & Enrichment Program

Policies

Club Meeting Days & Times

- When registering for multiple clubs or enrichment programs, please carefully review the days and times each activity is offered to avoid scheduling conflicts.
- If a scheduling conflict occurs, families will be asked to choose which program their child will attend.
- Refunds, credits, or make-up sessions will not be provided for missed classes due to scheduling conflicts with other activities.

Attendance & Make-Up Policy

- Students must attend the regular school day in order to participate in any after-school club or enrichment program. Exceptions may be considered only under unique circumstances and must receive prior approval from the Administration.
- If your child attends school but will not be participating in their scheduled club or enrichment program, please notify the school office.
- Refunds, credits, fee reductions, or make-up sessions are not available for student absences due to illness, vacations, appointments, or any other personal reasons.
- If a club instructor is unable to hold a scheduled session due to illness or an unforeseen circumstance, every effort will be made to schedule a make-up class. While we strive to make up all missed sessions, this cannot always be guaranteed.
- Please note that trial classes are not available for clubs or enrichment programs.

Behavior Expectations

To ensure a safe, positive, and enjoyable experience for all students participating in the **R.O.A.R. After School Program**, all school rules and behavior expectations remain in effect during clubs and enrichment activities.

- Students are expected to demonstrate respectful, responsible, and appropriate behavior at all times.
- Club instructors and school administrators reserve the right to remove a student from a session if their behavior is disruptive, unsafe, or inappropriate.
- Parents will be notified of behavioral concerns through an email and/or an incident report.
- Continued disruptive behavior may result in removal from the club or enrichment program.
- School administration reserves the right to remove a student from any club or enrichment activity at its discretion. No full or partial refunds will be issued if a student is removed due to behavioral concerns.

Inclement Weather & Cancellations

- If a club or enrichment session is canceled due to inclement weather or an emergency school closure, every effort will be made to schedule a make-up session when possible.
- Make-up sessions cannot be guaranteed.
- Refunds or credits will not be issued for cancellations due to weather, emergency closures, or circumstances beyond the school's control.

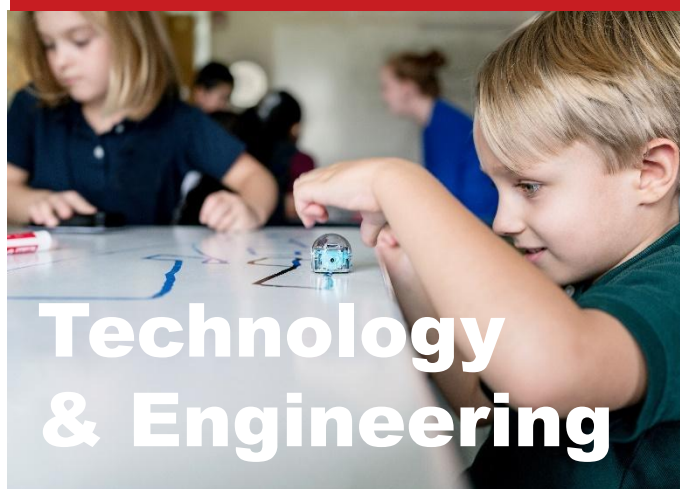
